2. Call customer service at 1-800-665-0728 or email remedy@dtxinternational.com to receive a prepaid label to ship the brake assembly back for a full refund.

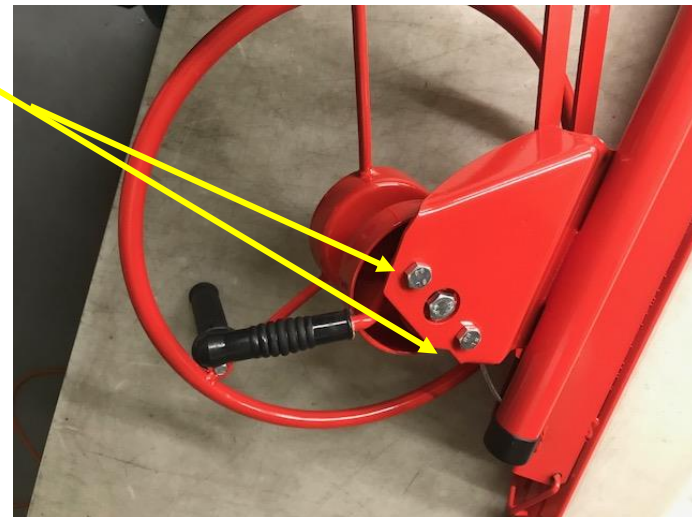

Once the brake assembly is removed, this will render the drywall lift useless, and we ask that you dispose of the rest of the unit immediately and never use it again. REMINDER: The drywall lift welds can break, which can cause the hoist to fail and injure users or others nearby.

BRAKE ASSEMBLY REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove (2) outer bolts from the wheel assembly.
2. Separate the wheel assembly from the main unit.
3. Remove the 3rd (center) bolt to free the brake assembly from the wheel.
4. Ship only the brake assembly for recall.
